This Department is provided to encourage proper cultural practices for New York State's newest agricultural industry to the end that consumers may benefit by better trees for their Christmas decorations.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR CHRISTMAS TREES

1. Entry forms and fees for this department must be received by the Entry Department, New York State Fair, no later than 4:30 p.m. on **Friday, August 8, 2008**.
2. Trees will be shown on the lawn of the northwest corner of the Master Spas Horticulture Building.
3. Trees for this competitive exhibit must have been grown in New York State on land owned or operated by the exhibitor.
4. Trees to be exhibited **must** be within the 5 to 8 feet range, measurements to be made from the bottom of the handle to the top of the tip.
 - a) Trees to be exhibited **should** have a well-trimmed clean handle. Standard trees **should** have a minimum of 10" and table tops a minimum of 6" from the bottom of the trunk to the first branch/branches.
5. No trees may be exhibited with limbs or foliage added that did not grow naturally in place.
6. Trees may be naturally grown or sheared and shaped by the exhibitor.
7. No holders should accompany trees. All trees will be supported in like manner.
8. **Only one tree or wreath may be entered in any class by an exhibitor.**
9. No premiums will be awarded in any class unless exhibits are worthy. Judge may eliminate any tree which is unqualified.
10. Exhibits must have tag attached showing number of exhibitor, class number and species of tree. After judging, exhibitor will be permitted to label his exhibit with his name and address.
11. Exhibits must be delivered to the northwest corner of the Master Spas Horticulture Building no later than 8:00 p.m. **Wednesday, August 20, 2008** – or they will not be eligible to compete.
12. **Exhibitors are not allowed in the tree judging area on Opening Day.**
