

2009 NEW YORK STATE FAIR LIVESTOCK ARRIVAL TIME SCHEDULE

4-H & OPEN CLASS DAIRY CATTLE ARRIVALS

Holstein & Milking Shorthorn Cattle - From **8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.** on Wed. Aug. 26. Colored Breeds - From **12:01 a.m., Wed.morning, September 2 until 9:00 a.m., Wed. Aug. 22.**

4-H & OPEN CLASS BEEF CATTLE ARRIVALS

First Rotation may arrive between 11:00 a.m. & 10:00 p.m., Wed, Aug. 26 or in place by 9:30 a.m., Thurs, Aug. 27.

Second Rotation may arrive between 6:00 p.m. & 10:00 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 30 or be in place by 9:30 a.m., Mon., Aug. 31.

Third Rotation may arrive between 6:00 p.m. & 10:00 p.m. on Thurs., Sept. 3 or be in place by 9:30 a.m., Fri., Sept. 4.

ATTENTION: No sheep, swine, goats or llamas will be allowed to unload into the barn until they have been inspected at the vet check station. The vet check station for sheep, goats & llamas is located under the bridge next to the Black Lot. The vet check station for swine will be the loading dock at the rear of the swine barn. The swine will be penned in a holding area until inspected by the vet & will then be moved to assigned pens. Once inspected, loading & unloading of all sheep, goats & llamas will take place at the rear of their barns. To reach these barns, exit Belle Isle Road on a route next to the Youth Activity area. See arrow route marked on the map at the back of the book. Except when loading or unloading, all livestock trucks must be parked in the TRUCK PARKING AREA (Black Lot). All exhibitor vehicles must be parked in assigned area. No parking behind barns will be allowed, VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED.

4-H DAIRY GOAT ARRIVALS

Any time between 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 mid. on Wed., Aug. 26 & 6:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. on Thurs., Aug. 27. Late arrivals by written permission from the 4-H Superintendent.

4-H MEAT GOAT ARRIVALS

They may arrive with Dairy Goats or they may arrive on Sat., Aug. 29 between 7:00 p.m. & 9:00 p.m. or Sun., Aug. 30 between 7:00 a.m. & 9:00 a.m.(for Sun. arrival, inspection will be at Horse Inspection Station just inside Gate #7). All Meat Goats must be in place by 9:00 a.m. on Sun., Aug. 30.

4-H SHEEP ARRIVALS

Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 mid., Wed., Aug. 26 & between 6:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. on Thurs., Aug. 27. Any other time, must be by written permission from 4-H Superintendent.

4-H SWINE ARRIVALS

Between the hours of 9:00 p.m. on Sat., Aug. 29 until 8:30 a.m. on Sun., Aug. 30.

OPEN DAIRY GOATS

Arrival time is between 12:01 a.m. & 9:00 a.m., Wed., Sept. 2. Before unloading at Goat Barn, the Goat Superintendent must be presented a signed Livestock Entry Permit issued at Vet Check Station.

OPEN MEAT GOATS

Arrival time is between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Friday, September 4. Before unloading at Goat Barn, the Goat Superintendent must be presented a signed Livestock Entry Permit issued at Vet Check Station.

OPEN SHEEP

Arrival time is Wed., Aug. 27 from 12:00 mid. until 10:00 a.m., Wed., Sept. 2. Any other time, must be by written permission from Open Sheep Superintendent.

OPEN SWINE

Arrival time is Wed., Sept. 2 from 10:00 p.m. until 12:00 mid. & Thurs., Sept. 3 from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

LLAMAS

Arrival time is between 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 mid. on Wed., Aug. 26 & 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m., Thurs., Aug. 27.

Livestock trucks & transport vehicles arriving at other than designated times may experience delays while awaiting vets at check in station, as well as an escort to unloading area. An escort fee may be assessed on vehicles arriving during Fair operating hours at other than arrival/release time periods specified. Map shows the traffic routes for livestock trucks.

4-H & OPEN CLASS DAIRY CATTLE RELEASE

On release days (Tues., Sept. 1 & Mon., Sept. 7) dairy cattle trucks will line up before 12:01 a.m. in single file on Rodeo Drive in the order of the zone letter provided. (Rodeo Drive runs along the front of the Fairgrounds between the exterior fence & the railroad tracks). Release numbers will be assigned by the Superintendent & the release permit will be authenticated by the Superintendent's staff before access to the Fairgrounds is permitted. Trucks without proper validation **will not be allowed to enter the Fairgrounds.** **There will be no exceptions!!**

The truck parking area is the Black parking lot on the west side of Route 695. Recommended route from the truck parking area (Black Lot) to Rodeo Drive is to exit the fairgrounds at Gate 6 onto State Fair Boulevard & to enter Rodeo Drive at Gate 4. See the marked route in the centerfold.

On Tues., Sept. 1 general release of Open & 4-H Holstein, & Milking Shorthorn show cattle will be by appointment only. All First Shift show cattle are to be removed from the Fairgrounds by 8:00 a.m. on Tues., Sept. 1.

Mon., Sept. 7, Labor Day, Second Shift release will be by appointment. & must be departed by 10:00 a.m. on Tues., Sept. 8.

4-H SHEEP, SWINE & GOAT RELEASE

4-H Sheep entered in 4-H will be released at 6:00 p.m., Tues., Sept. 1.

4-H Sheep entered in Open Class will be released at 6:00 p.m., Sun., September 6.

4-H Goats will be released at 7:00 p.m., Tues., Sept. 7 & must be removed by 10:00 p.m.

4-H & Empire Market Hogs released at 7:00 p.m., Wed., September 2.

OPEN CLASS SHEEP, SWINE & DAIRY & MEAT GOAT RELEASE

General Release will be between 9:00 p.m. & 12:00 mid. Mon., Sept. 7.

Open Goat Release will be in accordance with Zone Map.

OPEN CLASS LLAMA RELEASE

Between the hours of 1:00 p.m. & 5:00 pm. on Sat., Aug. 29.

OPEN & 4-H BEEF CATTLE RELEASE

First Rotation beef breeds will be released under the direction of the Beef Cattle Superintendent at 4:00 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 30.

Second Rotation beef breeds will be released at 4:00 p.m., Thurs., September 3.

Third Rotation beef breeds will be released at 4:00 p.m., Mon., Sept. 7.
